THANK YOU FOR MAINTAINING YOUR PROPERTY!

The Township receives numerous complaints each year relating to various issues, such as high grass, abandoned vehicles, dog waste, maintenance of buildings, disposal of garbage, rubbish, unkempt yards, unused or unsafe swimming pools, etc. By keeping your property in good order, you save the Township inspections, mailings and court filings. Thank you to those who continue to keep their property in great shape, thereby making Bensalem Township a better community.

Spring is almost here, when it arrives so will complaints about properties not being maintained in an acceptable manner per property maintenance codes. Each year, the Code Enforcement Inspectors manage a caseload in excess of 300 complaints. For those of you finding the need to file a complaint, please note; our mission is much like yours. We want to eliminate unsightly blight wherever it exists. Our inspectors work hard to investigate problem properties and begin the legal process for abatement. Many residents believe Township personnel can enter these blighted properties and clean up the mess. NOT SO. There is a legal process we are required to follow. Once we have complied with the law by following these procedures, we may be able to issue work orders for clean-up efforts to begin. Due to the nature of complaints, we address the importance of each one received, placing priority on those involving life/safety factors. Abandoned or foreclosed homes are often our biggest challenge. Tracking down the owners is the first step and not an easy one to achieve. Our objective is to encourage owners to maintain their properties in a manner that promotes the health, safety and well-being of the community. BENSALEM FIRE RESCUE

A fire can change your life in many ways that you cannot imagine. Knowing where to begin and who can help you is important. Bensalem Township Fire Rescue, Bensalem Township Emergency Management and the U.S. Fire Administration hopes you find the following information useful in getting through the things you must do after a fire.

If you are insured, contact your insurance company agent as soon as possible for detailed instructions. Your insurance agent will be able to assist by providing names of full service fire/smoke and water restoration companies that specialize in securing homes, inventory and removal of contents and 24-hour emergency service. It is our recommendation to delay major decisions in the restoration of your property until you have had adequate time to research the companies you choose to do business.

The following is a "WARNING" in reference to board up / restoration companies during times of emergency and disaster. The Bensalem Township Fire and Police Departments have had issues with numerous employees of board up / restoration companies appearing at the scenes of fires and aggressively soliciting work while providing false information to victim's of fires or personal disasters.

The following is an example of an actual event which occurred at a residential house fire in Bensalem Township: *An unknown male called the neighbor of a house fire victim and identified himself as being a representative of the emergency services. The male proceeded to state that he was contacted by the fire chief on scene who directed him to handle the securing of that fire victim's home. The victim's home had sustained significant damage due to the fire and he was not sure which direction to go for assistance. That same male proceeded to identify himself as being with the Bensalem Township's Emergency Management Agency. These statements were false and misleading. The subject's phone # was found to be spoofed from a FEMA number within Philadelphia. The investigation into this incident is on going.*

Bensalem Township does NOT have an established relationship, contract, or sponsor any one restoration company. We do require these companies to pay licensing fees to Bensalem on an annual basis in order to validate the companies dealing with the residents in the township. Contact Bensalem Fire Rescue at 215-633-3617 for a list of board up / restoration companies currently licensed to perform this work within Bensalem Township or for any further assistance.

The Bensalem officers joined approximately 25,000 uniformed law enforcement officers in the streets of New York City to honor the fallen heroes. Officer Ramos and Officer Liu were assassinated while sitting in their patrol car on a Brooklyn street.

The tribute to the fallen officers was an overwhelming experience. It was truly an honor for the Bensalem officers to be a part of the funerals. While the dangers of the job are never out of the minds of police officers, it is the love and support of their families, community, and other officers that make them continue to do their job with dedication and pride.


I-276 - I-95 UPDATE - BENSALEM BLVD. BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

In October 2014, the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission awarded Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., of Feasterville, Pa. the \$5.6 million contract to replace the bridge that carries Bensalem Boulevard over the PA Turnpike in Bensalem Township. The contractor has received the notice to proceed and started construction in early February. The bridge, located on the Turnpike mainline at milepost 355.0, is approximately four-miles east of the Bensalem Interchange (Exit #351). It is being replaced with a longer structure to accommodate a new, highway-speed link to I-95 that is currently in construction east of the bridge.

There will be some work needed in preparation for the relocation of utilities on Bensalem Boulevard which will include pruning and/or removing trees located in close proximity to the overhead utility lines. As work progresses within the project right-of-way, intermittent flagger controlled single-lane patterns will be used when restricting traffic on the bridge. The contractor will also begin installing the long-term traffic control signs next month to establish a safe work zone on I-276 between milepost 354.8 - 355.2 and on Bensalem Boulevard between U. S. Route 1 and Galloway Road.

Tentatively scheduled for demolition in March and depending on weather conditions, the contractor closed the Bensalem Boulevard bridge on March 2. A posted 1.2 mile

detour directing traffic around the closed bridge using New Falls Road, Main Street, and Hulmeville Road. Advance notice signage has been installed on the planned detour. (See map below.) Additional information about the project including the detour map will be posted on the I-95 project website at www.paturndpike95.com. The expected date for the completion of the project is fall 2015.




